Allen<sup>3</sup> Whitted** (Elbridge Mabrin<sup>2</sup>, Jonathan<sup>1</sup>)<sup>1</sup> was born 3 March 1860 in Ridgeport, Boone County, Iowa<sup>2,3</sup>, and died 4 July 1919 in Sarasota, Manatee County, Florida<sup>4</sup>. He married **(1) Allie Mae Graham<sup>4,5</sup>** 30 May 1894 in Bradenton, Manatee County, Florida<sup>6,7</sup>, daughter of Daniel Graham and Belle Rawls. She was born 1874<sup>8</sup>, and died January 1897 in Oneco, Manatee County, Florida<sup>8,9</sup>. He married **(2) Annie Viola Walker<sup>10</sup>** 23 December 1900 in Bradenton, Manatee County, Florida<sup>10</sup>, daughter of Oliver Walker and Sarah Head. She was born 23 August 1880 in Arcadia, DeSoto County, Florida<sup>10</sup>, and died 17 November 1960 in Sarasota, Sarasota County, Florida<sup>10</sup>.

### Notes for Allen Whitted:

According to the Evancos, Allen Whitted came with his father by horseback from Boone County, Iowa, to Manatee County, Florida. His mother and the rest of the family and their household goods came by train. With his father he raised citrus fruit which was sold to the New York trade using the railroad. He also dealt in real estate.

### Obituary:

"Allen Whitted Dies At Lockwood Ridge." - After several months of illness, Allan Whitted died at his home at Lockwood Ridge on the morning of July 4th. The funeral services were held at Rosemary Cemetery the next morning, conducted by the pastor of the Christian church of Braidentown.

"Mr. Whitted leaves a wife and ten children, and a number of relatives. His eldest son is still in the service, leaving with the Sarasota Militia April 1917.

"Out of town relatives at the funeral were his sister, Mrs. Mattie Davis of Terra Ceia, and his brother, F.A. Whitted of St. Petersburg. Mrs. Eliza Bass of Sarasota is also a sister.
