General Notes: According to one family researcher, Thomas Orange, Catherine Molsbee, who was born in Tennessee, married William Wallace of Livingston County, Kentucky about 1842. They had a son Hugh, born 1844 and a daughter Mary Elizabeth, born 1847. Shortly after Elizabeth was born, Catherine left her husband and son and went with her daughter to Equality, Illinois. When Elizabeth's mother Catherine died, in the early 1860s, Elizabeth was returned to William Wallace, her father, by a Mrs. Phillips. This researcher thinks that Catherine Phillips was Catherine Molsbee and that Elizabeth, her daughter, was William Wallace's daughter. This is all conjecture and has not been proven.

Declaration for Original Invalid Pension: Enrolled in 56th Reg. of Ill 15 Sept. 1861. Promoted to 2d Lieut. Co. "F", 120th Illinois Volunteers, commanded by Capt. William Roark. Resigned in Memphis, Tenn., 3 Jan. 1863. Currently (12 May 1879) residing in Bridgeport, Belmont Co., Ohio. He is 42. He describes the incident during the war that led to his disability: "About April 26 1862 while at Paducah Ky a violant [sic] storm arose which carried away nearly all the tents of the regiment; during the storm I was thoroughly drenched with the raing producing congestive chills and extreme debility from the effect of which I suffer from chronic liver complaint inflammation of kidneys and chronic rheumatism. I claim a pension on the loss of health from the above causes. Was treated by Regt Surgs of the 56th & 120th Illinois Vols--also on Sanitary boat "Sir William Wallace" from Memphis to Cario [sic] Ills [sic]. Since leaving the service, I have resided at Sandusky O, Harrisburg and Equality Ills and my occupation has been Inventor & Mechanic. Before my entry into the Service aforesaid I was of good, sound physical health, being at enrollment a Carriage Maker."

Zephaniah paid taxes in McCracken Co., KY, in 1872. Information given lists 1 white male over the age of 21, 1 enrolled in the militia, no children. No land or property of value listed. Does this mean that his family was not living with him at the time? Source: Commissioner's Book of Taxes for McCracken Co. for the year 1872. Fam. Hist. Ctr. Document says Mary died Jan. 16, 1929, in St. Petersburg, Fla., buried there also. Undertaker was Endicott Funeral Co. Anna states that Mary became ill with a cancerous fibroid uterine tumor four years before she died. She lived with Anna who took care of her. Medical expenses were: physician, \$155 unpaid balance; medicine, \$800; undertaker, \$362. The physician was Dr. O.O. Feaster. The doctor states that Mary lived with Anna for the past eight years. In the 1920 Census, Anna's last name was Betts, she was married but there was no husband listed. By 1929 she is Anna Heinkel. She must have married sometime after 1920.

It does not say Anna is widowed. Nine years later, in the application for reimbursement, she is Anna C. Heinkel. She must have married sometime before April 1929.

The Application for Reimbursement was made because Anna's mother was a pensioner (certificate #574887). Document says she died Jan. 16, 1929, in St. Petersburg, Fla., buried there also. Undertaker was Endicott Funeral Co. Anna states that Mary became ill with a cancerous fibroid uterine tumor four years before she died. She lived with Anna who took care of her. The telegram was sent from Deland, FL. Zephaniah Jr. was the uncle of Albert Whitted, son of his sister Julia Phillips Whitted. Albert Whitted died in a plane crash.

In the 1900 U.S. Census, Zephaniah and his family are living in Titusville, Brevard County, Florida. He and Mary have two children, Zephaniah and Olive. There is also living with them an adopted daughter, Mary, born Sept 1885, age 14, born Florida, father born - illegible, mother born Georgia.

Although the 1900 census gives Zephaniah's date of birth as Nov 1869, his gravestone says 1868 and his father gave his date of birth as 23 Nov 1868 when filling out his military pension forms.
