1. **Thomas¹ Healy** was born ca. 1790 in Co. Mayo Ireland¹, and died ca. 1864 in Derryfada, County Mayo, Ireland¹. He married **Mary O'Boyle** ca. 1820¹. She was born 1795 in Derryfadda, County Mayo Ireland¹, and died 1845 in Derryfadda, County Mayo, Ireland¹.

Notes for Thomas Healy:

Thomas Healy was born and died in County Mayo, Ireland. According to the family history written by his grandson, Patrick Healy in 1936, Thomas was born in 1790 and died in Derryfadda in 1864 of old age. According to Patrick, Thomas was well educated and could speak and write Latin, Greek, English and Gaelic. He married Mary O'Boyle and they settled in Collarua, south of Crossmolina in the townland of Derryfadda. She died of typhoid fever in 1845. All of their children but one, Mary, left Ireland to settle in America. We have not been able to verify any of this information and know nothing of Mary O'Boyle's family.

From his obituary in the "Elysian Enterprise:"

"The remains were conveyed to losco for interment followed by 150 teams, the largest procession that ever left our village, and was a tribute to the worth of a true and exemplary life."

On death record, his father is listed as Thomas Healy, born in Ireland; his mother is listed as Ann Healy, born Ireland.

Notes for Sarah Coleman:

Some sources say Sarah was born in Pennsylvania and some say Ireland. 1900 Census lists her as emigrating in 1853, born in Ireland. If she was born in 1835-36, then she was probably born in Ireland. Death record says Ireland.

According to death record, Sarah was born Oct., 1835; age was 73 yrs., 1 month, & 10 days which does not compute to Oct., 1835. Nor to the date given on family group sheets, May, 1835.

According to 1870 census, Sarah cannot read or write. Middle initial is A.

Notes for Patrick M. Healy:

Patrick Healy and Mary Hope and their four children, Patrick 9, Thomas, 6, Bridget, 4, and Mary, 2, left Collarua, Co. Mayo, Ireland, for America in 1866. They boarded the S.S. England in Queenstown on the evening of March 29 bound for New York City. A cholera epidemic broke out while en route and the ship was diverted to McNabs Island, near Halifax, in Canada. Mary, the youngest, died and was buried at sea. Passengers were quarantined on McNabs Island until May, when they were cleared for entry into New York. From there, the family travelled by train to Minnesota where other family members had settled. The family eventually settled in Faribault and later moved to Saint Paul.

Notes for Mary Hope:

Mary Hope Healy's birth date is questionable. On her gravestone, her year of birth is 1831 on her gravestone. At her death in 1898, her age is 62, making her birth about 1836. In the passenger manifest on the S.S. England in 1866, she is 34, putting her birth about 1832. In the 1875 state census she is 37, putting her birth about 1838. If she was born in 1831, she would have been 23 when she married. If born in 1838, she would have been 16.

Notes for Catherine Kathleen Healy:

Died age 85 or 93 according to family notes. Death certificate gives age at death as 53 (ca.1842), but she had to be older than that because she was married in 1853. She was most likely born sometime in the mid-1830s.

Obituary: Mrs. Catherine Philbin, at her late residence, 54 E. Huron St. Funeral takes place at 11 o'clock Saturday to Holy Name church, thence by cars [RR] to Calvary.
