Hubbard**<sup>8</sup> 18 Nov 1845 in Gallatin County, IL<sup>8</sup>, daughter of Robert Hubbard. She was born 02 Oct 1807 in Logan County, KY, and died Aft. 1865<sup>9</sup>. He married **(3) Unity Dewall**<sup>10</sup> 30 Sep 1866 in Saline Co., Illinois<sup>11</sup>. She died 19 Oct 1886<sup>12</sup>.

#### Notes for Jarvis Pierce:

Jarvis appears to have been born in Craftsbury, Vermont, not Worcester, Massachusetts. In the census records - 1850, 1870, 1880 - he always says he was born in Massachusetts. The Craftsbury records list the birth of seven children beginning with Mira and ending with Joseph Crawford. No parents are listed with the children, whose births go up to 1809, including Jarvis. Myra (Mira, Maritta] the first child is also listed as being born in Westminster, Mass., Jarvis and Rhodey Pirce as parents. No birth record for Jarvis has been found for Massachusetts yet. source:

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The 1800 Census, which was to be taken starting August 4th, lists a Jarvis Peirce in Westminster, Worcester Co., Massachusetts. The census lists 1 male, age 26-45 and 4 females, 2 ages 0-10, 1 age 10-16, and one age 26. Jarvis [Sr] would have been 28 in August, and Rhoda, 26. The female age 10-16 is unknown, but this is most likely Jarvis, Rhoda and family. If Jarvis Jr. was born in September, then he might have been born in Massachusetts rather than Vermont. Myra is listed in the births in Craftsbury with all the other children, yet she was born in Massachusetts. The family was in Craftsbury for the 1810 census.

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Obituary from The Local Record, Shawneetown, Gallatin County, Illinois:

"Uncle Jarvis Pierce, the oldest man in Harrisburg, died at his home in this place last Sunday morning. He was one of the founders of the town. He has many relatives in White and Jefferson counties, as well as Saline, and the greatest pleasure of his declining years was to attend the old settler's meetings at Mt. Vernon. He was an untiring worker to the day when his last sickness commenced, and the trees about the Saline county court house are a living monument to his industry and taste. He did not die, but fell asleep."

This was originally in the Harrisburg [Saline Co., Illinois] Chronicle and then copied into The Local Record.

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From a county history for Jefferson County, Illinois, which is where Jarvis was first married:

"Jarvis Pierce went to Harrisburg and was a "court-house fixture" there till he died. James, one of his boys, was elected County Clerk there and served many years."

This seems to indicate that Jarvis had more than one son. So far, only one has been identified: James Pierce. This son was found in the probate records which named James' daughter Eliza and her husband and children. If he had other sons, they must not have lived to 1880 when Jarvis died.

### Notes for Sally Wilkerson:

There is a Robert Wilkerson in the 1850 Jefferson County, Illinois, census who is 42 years old and is possibly a brother of Sally. Among his children is a son named Jarvis.

There is also a John Wilkerson in the 1820 Illinois census in Jefferson County.

A John Wilkerson married Elizabeth Allen Thomas in 1807 in Lebanon, Tennessee. She was his second wife. He was born in 1767 in Virginia. In May 1818 a group of families moved from Lebanon, Wilson County, Tennessee, to Moore's Prairie, Jefferson County, Illinois. Moore's Prairie is in the southeast corner of the county. John and Elizabeth both had children from their prior marriages. Together they had Elizabeth, Sallie, Jane, Mastin, Emily, Ransom, Martha and John Jr. This Sallie could be the Sallie who married Jarvis Pierce.

#### Notes for Elewisa A. R. Hubbard:

In papers sent to me by Bea Whitted, wife of George Bracie Whitted, and daughter-in-law of Julia Phillips whose mother, Mary E. Phillips was the daughter of Elewisa, Elewisa's name is given as Adeline E. Rumsey. The person who wrote the notes referred to her as Grandmother Rumsey, so the writer was probably Julia herself. She notes that Jarvis Pearce married Adaline Rumsey. In Mary E. Pierce Phillips death certificate, her mother's name, Adyline Rumsey, is written over what appears to be another name but smudged out. Her name has also been given as Elewisa A.R. Gatewood. She was married to Senator William Jefferson Gatewood and when he died she married Jarvis Pierce. Other sources list her maiden name as Hubbard and her father as Robert but none of this has been verified. William Jefferson Gatewood's mother was a Hubbard.

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Mary E. Pierce Phillips (Mollie Phillips) is listed in her father's will but none of her children are.

## Notes for Unity Dewall:

Unity had married Daniel Barnes in 1850, but in 1860 she was living with the Pierces, listed in the census as Unite, along with her daughter Louise Barnes, age 3. Unity was listed as a servant in the household in 1860, but was listed as Jarvis' wife in the 1870 and 1880 censuses; she died after Jarvis.

Eliza is a child of Jarvis Pierce, presumably by his first wife, Sally Wilkerson. Great grandchildren of Jarvis are mentioned in his probate records; since he married Sally in 1821, children of Jarvis' first wife, Sally, would have been able to have had grandchildren by the time Jarvis died in 1880. Elewisa and Jarvis married in 1845 and only had one child, Mary E. Pierce. She is mentioned in her father's will, but none of her children is mentioned.

Allen, Drusilla's sister [Jefferson County Marriages, Vol. 6, p.39, January 17, 1876]. A marriage license for Druzilla C. Allen and Homer Thomas was issued September 15, 1870 [Jefferson County Marriages, Vol. 3,

License #151]. These can be found in FHC Microfilms 1,004,738 and 1,004,739.

Emma would have been 14 in 1870 but Drusilla would have been about 19. In 1876, Emma would have been 20. It is more likely that the marriage records are correct and the probate records have the names confused. One would need to pore through the probate records to look for other references or signatures. It gives his father's birthplace as Alabama but Charles' father was born in Tennessee. Living with them is an Orlum J. Tate, age 18, nephew. I am not sure why the wife and daughter are not mentioned in the will but the age is right, the middle initial is right, the nephew is a Tate, and the daughter is named after his sister.

An "Application for Reimbursement" was made by Anna C. Heinkel on 8 April 1929 because her mother had been a pensioner (certificate #574887). Document says Mary died Jan. 16, 1929, in St. Petersburg, Fla., buried there also. Undertaker was Endicott Funeral Co. Anna states that Mary became ill with a cancerous fibroid uterine tumor four years before she died. She lived with Anna who took care of her. Medical expenses were: physician, \$155 unpaid balance; medicine, \$800; undertaker, \$362. The physician was Dr. O.O. Feaster. The doctor states that Mary lived with Anna for the past eight years. In the 1920 Census, Anna's last name was Betts, she was married but there was no husband listed. By 1929 she is Anna Heinkel. She must have married sometime after 1920.

He describes the incident during the war that led to his disability: "About April 26 1862 while at Paducah Ky a violant [sic] storm arose which carried away nearly all the tents of the regiment; during the storm I was thoroughly drenched with the raing producing congestive chills and extreme debility from the effect of which I suffer from chronic liver complaint inflammation of kidneys and chronic rheumatism. I claim a pension on the loss of health from the above causes. Was treated by Regt Surgs of the 56th & 120th Illinois Vols--also on Sanitary boat "Sir William Wallace" from Memphis to Cario [sic] Ills [sic]. Information given lists 1 white male over the age of 21, 1 enrolled in the militia, no children. No land or property of value listed. Does this mean that his family was not living with him at the time? Source: Commissioner's Book of Taxes for McCracken Co. for the year 1872. Fam. Hist. Ctr.
