
Descendants of John & Margaret Miller of Kendal

First Generation

1. **John Miller**¹ was born ca. 1695,² died on 24 Apr 1778 in Westmoreland County, England^{3,4} about age 83, and was buried on 28 Apr 1778 in Kendal, Westmorland, England.⁵

General Notes:

The Miller family goes back to the town of Kendal, also known as Kirkby Kendal, in what used to be Westmorland County, but is now part of Cumbria County in the far northwest of England.

In the northwest floor of Holy Trinity Church in Kendal, Cumbria, England, there is a memorial inscription which reads:

"In m. John Miller later Alderman of this Town, who d. April 24th 1778 aged 83 Y. Also of Margaret his Wife who d. 29 Day of March 1763 aged 54 Y."

Margaret was a widow when she married John on 18 Feb 1739 in Kendal and was listed as Mrs. Holme on the marriage record. Her previous husband was John Holme, Esq., mayor of Kendal when he died in 1737.

John Miller wrote his will in 1777, and died the following year. In this will, John mentions his children Thomas, William, Dorothy and Rebecca. His wife is not mentioned since she died before him, in 1763.

Margaret died on 29 March 1763 and was buried on 2 April. The burial in the parish register for that date reads, "Margaret wife of Mr. John Millers of Market Place." John died 24 April 1778 and was buried on 28 April, age 86, living at Stricklandgate. The age is different from that given in the memorial. John Miller would have been born about 1692-1695 and his wife Margaret about 1709.

There is a chart which has been passed down in the family showing Miller ancestry. This chart shows William Miller's parents as John Miller and his wife Maude. There is nothing on the chart to indicate where the name Maude came from. John's wife was Margaret, not Maude. The chart was possibly in the handwriting of Francis Benjamin Miller, son of Joseph Dundas Miller, or Frederick Spurstow Miller, son of Charles Edward Miller, and may have come from the research of Francis Spurstow Miller, son of Francis Benjamin Miller.

John married **Margaret**¹ on 18 Feb 1739 in Kendal, Westmorland, England.⁸ Margaret was born ca. 1709,⁹ died on 29 Mar 1763 in Kendal, Westmorland, England⁴ about age 54, and was buried on 2 Apr 1763 in Kendal, Westmorland, England.¹⁰

General Notes:

Margaret Holme was the widow of John Holme, Esq. in 1739 when she married John Miller. John Holme was mayor of Kendal at the time of his death. He and Margaret had children, including a daughter, Mary, who was born after his death. Her maiden name is unknown.

Children from this marriage were:

- 2 F i. **Rebecca Miller**¹¹ was christened on 8 Jul 1741 in Kendal, Westmorland, England.¹²

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General Notes: In one set of christening records, Rebecca is listed as Rebecca Miller; in another she is Rebecca Millner. Both spellings were used at that time.

- 4 F iii. **Dorothy Miller**¹¹ was christened on 12 Oct 1746 in Kendal, Westmorland, England.¹⁵

General Notes: In one set of christening records for Kendal, the daughter born to Mr. Jno. & Margt. Miller of Market Place is Dorothy. The name of the family looks like it was Milnor and was written over to be Miller. In another set of christening records, it is Margaret born to Mr. Jno. & Margt. Milnor of Market Place. Both were born on the same date. The names Miller, Millner, Milnor were used interchangeably. This daughter might have been Dorothy Margaret or perhaps the name was entered incorrectly in the records. She is mentioned in her father's will as Dorothy.

General Notes:

William Miller is listed in the parish registers of St. Nicholas Church, Liverpool, as a mercer and draper from the 1782 christening of his daughter Elizabeth; from 1788 until 1800 he is listed as a silk mercer at his children's christenings.

William married **Mary Spurstow**,²⁵ daughter of **George Spurstow** and **Elizabeth Hayes**, on 21 Sep 1779 in Chester, Cheshire, England.^{26,27} Mary was born about 1 Jun 1756 in Chester, Cheshire, England,²⁸ was christened on 1 Jun 1756 in Chester, Cheshire, England,²⁹ and died in 1832³⁰ about age 76.

General Notes: According to notes of Hope Healy Koontz, who researched the Millers, Elizabeth Hayes Spurstow died without a will. Her daughter Mary Spurstow Miller was appointed to administer her estate.

- 9 F iv. **Rebecca Miller**^{25,36,42} was born on 22 Aug 1785 in Liverpool, Lancashire, England.⁴³
General Notes: Mentioned in her brother Joseph Dundas Miller's will, written in 1847. Also, a witness at her brother George Spurstow Miller's marriage to Margaret Warren in 1824.

- Baptism: St. Nicholas Church, 4 Sep 1785, Liverpool, Lancashire, England.⁴²
- 10 M v. **William Spurstow Miller**⁴⁴ was born on 27 Apr 1788 in Liverpool, Lancashire, England,⁴⁵ died on 14 Oct 1850 in Bootle, Lancashire, England³⁰ at age 62, and was buried in 1850 in Bootle, Lancashire, England.
- General Notes: Miller's Castle was built by William Spurstow Miller about 1824. This occupied the site which is now the junction of Miller's Bridge with the dock road (Regent Road). The home no longer is standing but Miller's Pub, at the end of Miller's Bridge, is currently on this spot (1988). Information on Miller's Castle was taken from *The Story of Bootle* by C. Lamb.
- The firm of Miller & Peel continued after his death as 1868: Miller, Peel and Boteler; 1870: Miller, Peel and Hughes; 1880: Miller, Peel, Hughes & Co., 6 Percy Bldgs., Eberle St.; 1890: practice was at 43 Castle St. and remained here until 1932; 1895: Miller, Peel, Hughes, Rutherford & Co.; 1905: Rutherfords; 1932: Rutherfords, North House, 17 North John St., Liverpool.

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attorney, born in county, house: Castle. Over age 15 census age is recorded as the youngest of 5 years, so Wm. Miller is between 45 & 50

- Burial Fact: Grave #37, 1850.
- Gravestone Inscription: Sacred to the memory of William Spurstow Miller, Founder of this church, who departed this life on the 5th October 1850, age 62 yrs. Also, In memory of Frances Wilson, mother-in-law of the above, who departed this life on the 6th of July, 1852, aged 87 yr.

William married **Frances Wilson**, daughter of **Unknown** and **Frances**.

George married **Margaret Warren**³⁰ on 8 Apr 1824 in Rostherne, Cheshire, England.^{30,73} Margaret was born in 1796.

13. Joseph Dundas Miller^{60,61} (*William*², *John*¹) was born on 3 Oct 1792 in Liverpool, Lancashire, England,^{7,60} died on 30 Oct 1847 in Funchal, Madeira^{62,63} at age 55, and was buried in Funchal, Madeira.⁶⁴

General Notes: Joseph Dundas Miller was in Bahia, Brazil, 1814-1820 and went back again in 1821.

Noted events in his life were:

- Baptism: St. Nicholas Church Liverpool, Lancashire, England, 13 Dec 1792.⁶⁰

- Occupation: Merchant, 1821.¹⁰⁰

- Residence: 1821, Bahia, Brazil.¹⁰⁰

- Residence: Between 1823 and 1833, Sao Paulo, Brazil.

- Residence: 2 Plympton Terrace, Liverpool, Between 1837 and 1841.¹⁰¹

- Residence: Fort Place, Walton-On-the-Hill, Liverpool, Between 1841 and 1847.¹⁰²

- Notice of Death: "Died. Oct 30, at Madeira, Joseph Miller, Esq., of this town.", 1847.¹⁰³

- Residence: 1847, Bootle, Lancashire, England.¹⁰⁴

- Will: 30 Aug 1847, Liverpool, Lancashire, England.¹⁰⁵ The will was nine pages.

Executors were William John Tomlinson, broker, William Gordon, merchant, and Samuel Gath, broker. All were from Liverpool. William John Tomlinson was probably the brother of his wife, Elizabeth Tomlinson.

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- Probate: 7 Dec 1847, Liverpool, Lancashire, England.¹⁰⁶

Joseph married **Elizabeth Tomlinson**,^{105,107} daughter of **Dr. John Tomlinson** and **Dorothy Spurstow**, on 15 May 1821 in Neston, Cheshire, England.^{100,108,109,110} Elizabeth was born on 17 Sep 1794 in Chester, Cheshire, England,^{30,111} was christened on 25 Nov 1794 in Chester, Cheshire, England,¹¹² and died on 18 Jan 1852 in Liverpool, Lancashire, England¹¹³ at age 57.

Marriage Notes: Witnesses for the marriage were Charles Tomlinson, brother of the bride, W. Miller, the groom's father or brother, Anne Tomlinson, sister of the bride, John Ansdell, husband of the bride's maternal aunt, and John Miller, brother of the groom. Rev. Charles H. Miller, brother of the groom, performed the ceremony.

Noted events in their marriage were:

- Marriage Fact: Joseph and Elizabeth were first cousins.
- Newspaper announcement: Liverpool Mercury Etc, 18 May 1821, Liverpool, Lancashire, England.¹¹⁴ "On Tuesday last, at Neston, Mr. Joseph Miller, merchant, Bahia, to Elizabeth, daughter of the late Mr. Tomlinson, surgeon, Chester."
- Church: St. Mary's & St. Helen's Church, Neston, Cheshire, England.¹¹⁵

After their daughter Ethel was badly burned and spent a year in a hospital in Pittsburgh, Charles took Ethel to England in July 1897 on the SS *Rhynland* for more extensive medical care; the rest of family followed in December; they stayed in England for about ten years, living in different places. Charles left London in November 1907, supposedly to keep books for a cattle ranch in the United States. The manifest of the SS *Lusitania*, which arrived in New York, indicated that he was going to Missoula, Montana. I believe the cattle ranch position fell through because Annie and some of the children came from England to join him in Cheyenne, Wyoming, in December of that year.
