

Descendants of Bridget Healy and Frank Lorig

1. Bridget³ Healy (Patrick², Thomas¹) was born about November 23, 1861, in Collarua, County Mayo, Ireland, and died April 14, 1890, in St. Paul, Ramsey County, Minnesota. She married Frank Lorig about 1883. He was born May 6, 1862, and died September 24, 1890, in St. Paul, Ramsey County, Minnesota.

Notes for Bridget Healy:

Baptized November 23, 1861, in Addergoole Parish, County Mayo, Ireland.

Residence was Collyrue. Witnesses were Thomas Hope and Mary Leonard.

Buried April 14, 1890, Calvary Cemetery, St. Paul, Minnesota, Lot 2, Block 38, Sec. 16, Grave 10. Age 27.

Burial date same as death date. Burial date could be wrong. Burial information from Superintendent of Calvary Cemetery, St. Paul, Minnesota.

Notes for Frank Lorig:

According to death record, his parents were of German nationality.

Buried October 24, 1890, Calvary Cemetery, St. Paul, Minnesota, Lot 2, Block 38, Section 16. Age 29. Burial date was one month after death date. Burial date could be wrong. Burial date from Superintendent of Calvary Cemetery, St. Paul, Minnesota.

Later Note:

Further research uncovered a marriage for Irene. She was married 29 December 1915 in Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, California, to Reginald Alexander Marshall, born 9 May 1882, Peterborough, England, died 20 September 1955, Denver, Colorado. Irene was living in 1920, 1930 and 1940 in Denver, last address: 3505 W. Scott Place. According to a biographical sketch of Reginald in an annual report for 1969 by the Denver Museum of Natural History, Reginald's family moved to Denver in 1893. He worked for the Denver & Rio Grande Railroad and later ran the R.S. Marshall real estate firm. Reginald and his wife, Irene Lorig Marshall, had no children.
