She married **Zephaniah Phillips**⁷ 02 Oct 1862 in Harrisburg, Saline, IL^{8,9}, son of George W. Phillips. He was born 02 Mar 1837 in Toronto, Canada^{10,11,12,13,14}, and died 21 Jan 1903 in St. Petersburg, Hillsborough, FL¹⁵.

The Application for Reimbursement was made by Anna C. Heinkel because her mother was a pensioner (certificate #574887). Document says Mary died Jan. 16, 1929, in St. Petersburg, Fla., buried there also. Undertaker was Endicott Funeral Co. Anna states that Mary became ill with a cancerous fibroid uterine tumor four years before she died. She lived with Anna who took care of her. Medical expenses were: physician, \$155 unpaid balance; medicine, \$800; undertaker, \$362. The physician was Dr. O.O. Feaster. The doctor states that Mary lived with Anna for the past eight years. In the 1920 Census, Anna's last name was Betts, she was married but there was no husband listed. By 1929 she is Anna Heinkel. She must have married sometime after 1920.

Doc. 252 [Declaration for Original Invalid Pension]: Enrolled in 56th Reg. of Ill 15 Sept. 1861. Promoted to 2d Lieut. Co. "F", 120th Illinois Volunteers, commanded by Capt. William Roark. Resigned in Memphis, Tenn., 3 Jan. 1863. Currently (12 May 1879) residing in Bridgeport, Belmont Co., Ohio. He is 42. He describes the incident during the war that led to his disability: "About April 26 1862 while at Paducah Ky a violent [sic] storm arose which carried away nearly all the tents of the regiment; during the storm I was thoroughly drenched with the rain producing congestive chills and extreme debility from the effect of which I suffer from chronic liver complaint inflammation of kidneys and chronic rheumatism. I claim a pension on the loss of health from the above causes. Was treated by Regt Surgs of the 56th & 120th Illinois Vols--also on Sanitary boat "Sir William Wallace" from Memphis to Cairo [sic] Ills [sic]. Since leaving the service, I have resided at Sandusky O, Harrisburg and Equality Ills and my occupation has been Inventor & Mechanic. Before my entry into the Service aforesaid I was of good, sound physical health, being at enrollment a Carriage Maker."

Zephaniah paid taxes in McCracken Co., KY, in 1872. Information given lists 1 white male over the age of 21, 1 enrolled in the militia, no children. No land or property of value listed. Does this mean that his family was not living with him at the time? Source: Commissioner's Book of Taxes for McCracken Co. for the year 1872. Fam. Hist. Ctr. Microfilm 008148, McCracken Co., KY, Taxbooks 1868-1873. p.32. [Doc. 22]

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Zephaniah Phillips Jr. sent a telegram August 20, 1923 to Mrs. James A. Whitted [Frances Fick Whitted] expressing sympathy at Albert Whitted's death. The telegram was sent from Deland, FL

Notes for Anna Phillips:

In the Application for Reimbursement (April, 1929) for care of her mother she states her age as 53; using the 1866 date (birth) she should be 62. She also lists her middle initial as C. In the document she signs as Anna Clara Heinkel. [Doc. 279]

In the 1920 census, she states also that she is 53. This age is probably right. The Reimbursement Application date is April, 1929. In this census, Anna's last name is Betts. There is a daughter, Eva D. Betts, age 13. No husband is listed. It does not say Anna is widowed. Nine years later, in the application for reimbursement, she is Anna C. Heinkel. She must have married in the twenties.
