

Descendants of Samuel Ashcroft

1. **Samuel¹ Ashcroft^{1,2}** was born ca. 1740³, and died 1821 in Manchester, England⁴. He married **Mary Rudd⁴** 23 Oct 1764 in Stockport, Cheshire, England⁵. She was born ca. 1740⁶, and died 11 Feb 1821 in Manchester, England⁷.

Notes for Samuel Ashcroft:

One researcher and descendant, Rodney Kerr, thinks that a Henry Ashcroft is possibly the father of Joshua. Henry was recorded in the Manchester directories of the 1780s as a slater (slaytor) of Dolefield, a craft area of old inner Manchester according to one source. In 1800 a Joshua Ashcroft, slater, was in Hulme, also a craft area. A William Harrison was recorded at Dolefield in 1788 and as a dyer at 4 Water Street in Hulme in 1800. Hulme was an area of Manchester. William Harrison was the father of an Esther Harrison who was baptised at Mossley, Manchester 11 April 1784. Esther Harrison became the wife of Joshua Ashcroft. If Henry is the father of Joshua, why is no male, in succeeding generations, named after him?

Another researcher and descendant, Tony Ashcroft, "managed to build up a picture of Henry's life and found that he came from Northenden (then called Northen), Cheshire. This is a neighbouring parish of Ashton on Mersey and I sense that Henry and indeed other Ashcrofts in this area of North Cheshire are related to Samuel and family." "More research needs to be done. Both Henry and Samuel were slaters as were all of Samuel's sons. It is very possible that Henry and Samuel are related."

Marriage Notes for Samuel Ashcroft and Mary Rudd:

The marriage of Samuel Ashcroft to Mary Rudd is an assumption. Our Samuel might have been married to a different Mary. We know her name is Mary from the baptismal registers of their children. This marriage took place in October of 1764 and their first child was born in July 1765. The marriage was in Stockport, which is in the same general vicinity in which they lived and died. Further research might confirm this.

He married **(2) Esther Harrison**¹⁴⁶ 19 May 1802 in Manchester, Lancashire, England^{146,147}, daughter of William Harrison and Sarah Slater. She was born ca. 11 Apr 1784 in Mossley, Manchester, Lancashire, England^{148,149}.

Manchester Mercury and Harrop's General Advertiser, Tuesday July 22 1806

"On Thursday last a man accidentally fell from the roof of a very lofty warehouse in Crow Alley, St Anne's Square, and was so dreadfully maimed that he expired in less than half an hour." (This is on the fourth page at the bottom of the fifth column. The paper came out every Tuesday).

Wheeler's Manchester Chronicle, Saturday July 19 1806 Volume XXVI

"Casualties - A child killed by a cart at Bolton. A man drowned at Holt Town and a child killed by a horse at Knott Lanes, near Ashton - this arose from the mischievous and very dangerous practice of pulling hair from a horse's tail, when at grass. A man killed by falling from a warehouse in Back Square." (This is in the fifth column of the last page. The paper came out every Saturday.)

Note from Tony Ashcroft: These two brief reports conflict on location but I have a street map of Manchester from the period and Back Square and Crow Alley were very close to each other in the

vicinity of St Anne's Square. They no longer exist.

Notes for Esther Harrison:

There is also an Esther, dau of John Harrison and Anne, christened 2 November 1777 in Mossley, Manchester, Lancashire, so it is possible that John and Anne are her parents rather than William and Sarah. John and Anne's place of abode was illegible but he was a clothier. The 1777 record was from the Church of England, Chapelry of Mossley, Lancashire. Bishop's transcripts for Mossley, 1769-1838, baptisms and burials, 1769-1838 - FHL MF 1545445, items 1-3; the 1784 record was from the Parish register transcripts, 1756-1821, FHL MF 223722. The christening for 1777 is most likely on this MF also. In the 1784 record, William Harrison is a weaver living at Broadcarr. There is a Broadcarr Ln., Mossley, Ashton-Under-Lyne, Lancashire. This may have been where they lived.

Notes for Hannah Smith:

In the parish register, Chapel of Disley, Stockport, a notation on the entry for the baptism of her son John, born Oct. 5, baptized Dec. 12, 1828, says "Hannah Smith, Lime Kilns, Disley, spinster." Lime Kilns refers to the Lime Kilns that were located at the time near what is now Marple, just south of the Stockport Rd. (A626) and north of Disley. Both are SE of Manchester.

Meifod can also be spelled Myfod.

Hannah Smith died of dropsy. How does Rodney Kerr know this? She died in Wolverhampton 4 July 1869, age 71. Does he have her death cert? Age is in the GRO index. Exact date and cause must be from the death cert. OR from a death record, parish registers, or Bishop's transcripts?

Notes for Hannah Ashcroft:

Hannah Ashcroft, daughter of William Ashcroft and Hannah Smith, was baptized in the parish church in Wednesbury 12 April 1829. We know that she was married to a Mr. Hughes. In her father's will, written in 1878, he mentions his daughter Hannah Hughes; she and her sister are executrixes.

Hannah Ashcroft married a man named Hughes after the 1861 census but before her father died in 1878. A marriage for a Wm. Hughes and a Hannah Ashcroft is

listed for June Qtr. 1861, district of Fylde, vol. 8e, p.730 in the Civil Registration Index. This district is West of Preston and North of Liverpool and lay at the time between Wolverhampton, Bilston and Dudley.

There is a Hannah Hughes in the 1871 and 1881 censuses married to William, living in Sedgley, Staffordshire. This is not our Hannah because in the 1881 census, our Hannah was living with her sister Ann Duckworth in Wall Heath, Staffordshire, and was a widow in 1881. The sons listed in the censuses are too old for the Hannah and William who were married in 1861. Hannah and William were nailmakers.

There is another William and Hannah Hughes in the 1871 census. This Hannah is 30 (and should be 40) and was born in Bromsgrove, Worcestershire. Bromsgrove is much further south of Wednesbury and in another county. There is one child, Lizzie Hughes, 18 mos.

There is a Hannah P. Hughes in 1871 married to John Hughes. They are living in Wall Heath, Kingswinford Parish, and this Hannah was born in Kingswinford. She is 38. There are three children: Louisa, age 11, James S., age 6, and John, age 3. No children are listed with our Hannah in the 1881 census in Wall Heath. This Hannah P. Hughes is also listed in the 1881 census, a widow, with her three children. She is a dressmaker. Not our Hannah.

There is a birth registered in the District of Holborn, which includes the township or parish of CLerkenwell, and which spans the boundaries of the counties of London and Middlesex.
