

Descendants of Elbridge Mabrin Whitted and Caroline E. Aldridge

Generation No. 1

1. Elbridge Mabrin² Whitted (Jonathan¹)¹ was born 28 February 1824 in Chatham County, North Carolina², and died 6 January 1899 in Oneco, Manatee County, Florida. He married **Caroline E. Aldridge³** 9 May 1846 in Rockville, Parke County, Indiana⁴, daughter of Elijah Aldridge and Jane White. She was born 20 April 1822 in Montgomery County, Kentucky^{5,6}, and died 29 August 1900 in Oneco, Manatee County, Florida⁷.

Notes for Elbridge Mabrin Whitted:

The following information is from Col. Michael and Anita Evanco:

New Cemetery is now called Major Adams Cemetery.

"Elbridge departed Boone Co., IA on his trek to Florida, with his sons, ending in Manatee Co., FL. Subsequently, he had his family come by train--although he came by horseback. He stopped in Tuscaloosa Co., Alabama to visit with his sister, Nancy Caroline Kelly. He, also, was instrumental in taking care of his brother's, Isaac, child, Charley, who died while Elbridge was visiting with his sister. Elbridge arrived in Manatee County, FL and settled on land in Oneco. The Manasota Cemetery is now located on what was once Elbridge's land. Elbridge was a successful orange grower and he lived the rest of his life in Manatee County. He died at Oneco. The authors have a newspaper clipping commemorating his death. He was buried in New Cemetery (now called Major Adams Cemetery), Bradenton, Manatee Co., FL. The gravesite was unmarked when the authors found it. The authors were instrumental in having a plaque erected on the mastabas. Caroline, his wife, is lying beside Elbridge. Allen Whitted, son of Elbridge, purchased the gravesite, prepared the gravesite and personally buried Elbridge Whitted. Allen performed the same actions for his mother.

"Elbridge and Caroline (Aldridge) Whitted are located in northwest corner of the lot in New Cemetery. Allen's first wife, Allie Mae Graham, is buried in the southwest corner of the same lot. Allen performed the same service for his wife.

"The newspaper article reads, 'An Aged Citizen Dead. Mr. E. Whitted, an aged and honored citizen of Manatee County passed away suddenly from cerebral hemorage on Thursday night at the advanced age of 76 years. Mr. Whitted was a native of North Carolina, but lived several years in the West before coming to Florida about 20 years ago. Since coming to Manatee county, he had resided on Orange Ridge, about three miles south of town, surrounded by sons and daughters and their families, all of whom have nice orange groves and are prosperous. Funeral services were conducted by Rev. W. B. Tresca on Friday afternoon, and the body laid to rest in the Manatee Cemetery.' "

His mother and the rest of the family and their household goods came by train. With his father he raised citrus fruit which was sold to the New York trade using the railroad. Obituary:

"Allen Whitted Dies At Lockwood Ridge." - After several months of illness, Allan Whitted died at his home at Lockwood Ridge on the morning of July 4th. The funeral services were held at Rosemary Cemetery the next morning, conducted by the pastor of the Christian church of Braidentown.

"Mr. Whitted leaves a wife and ten children, and a number of relatives. His eldest son is still in the service, leaving with the Sarasota Militia April 1917.

"Out of town relatives at the funeral were his sister, Mrs. Mattie Davis of Terra Ceia, and his brother, F.A. Whitted of St. Petersburg. Mrs. Eliza Bass of Sarasota is also a sister.

"The Times extends sympathy to the family in their bereavement."
