1. Thomas¹ Whitted, Sr., Esq. was born ca. 1754 in Orange County, North Carolina¹, and died 5 August 1820 in Orange County, North Carolina^{2,3,4}. He married **(1) Unknown** ca. 1774⁵. She died ca. 1805. He married **(2) Sarah** 4 September 1813⁶.

Notes for Thomas Whitted, Sr., Esq.:

My notes: Don Whitted says "we think Thomas's father was Robert Whitehead, but we are not sure yet." 1983. He also says "Thomas must have changed his name from Whitehead to Whitted sometime between his first and second child."

- 5 iv. Mary Whitted, born ca. 1780 in Orange County, North Carolina; died Bef. 1850 in Lawrence County, Indiana³². She married (2) Thomas Pleasants 9 December 1801 in Orange County, North Carolina^{33,34}; born ca. 1789 in North Carolina³⁵.

Notes for Mary Whitted:

Mary had at least one child out of wedlock. Father may have been Isacc Suggard. Child Jonathan Whitted.

Thomas and Mary moved to Lawrence County, Indiana, in the early 1800s. They may have moved around 1816 with her brother, John Whitted Sr., when he came. Jonathan did not come with them.

Notes for Thomas Whitted, Jr.:

Donald P. Whitted notes that Hugh Whitted, another researcher, says that there were 15 children in this family, 10 male, and 5 female. Sidney is Hugh's ancestor. The Evancos list 9 children in this family, naming only Sidney, as the 9th child. They also have a note about Sidney:

"A mystery remains as to the parentage of Sidney Whitted. One family genealogist suggests that his father was 'James Whitted' (born ca. 1783). Another source suggests that Sidney Whitted was a son of Thomas Whitted Jr. (born 1780 - 1784). The authors leave this complex problem to be resolved by the reader."
