

Descendants of William & Jenet Trimingham of Fishlake, Yorkshire

First Generation

1. **William Trimingham**¹ died in 1527 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England.¹

General Notes: The family name in Fishlake, back in the 1500s and 1600s was spelled Trymingham (and other variations), I have chosen to use the same spelling for all of the family, Trimingham.

William had a will, written and probated in 1527, which puts his death in 1527. In his will he asked to be buried at the Church of St. Cuthbert at Fishlake. His wife Jenet is mentioned in his will, but most of his estate was left to his son John.

Information on the Trimingham family of Fishlake is from William E. Trimingham's research on the family. Andrew Trimingham, of Bermuda and England, provided much of the information on the Bermuda branch of the family.

Noted events in his life were:

- Will: 13 Nov 1527, Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England.²
- Probate: Granted to son John, 15 Jan 1528, Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England.¹

William married **Jenet**.¹

General Notes: According to William E. Trimingham, family researcher, this John left a will. His wife was not mentioned so she may have died before him. Most of his estate was left to the two older sons with some to go to Francis, the youngest son and a minor at the time.

- Will: 3 Dec 1554, Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England.³

General Notes: According to extensive research done by William E. Trimingham, William left a will which was probated 14 December 1587. His wife, one son and four daughters were named in the will. He requested to be buried in the chancel of the church at Fishlake. Three of his daughters received £100 each, less to his married daughter Elizabeth Gelstrop, and the bulk of the estate went to his wife and son John. The son, John, married Brigitta, or Bridget.

Noted events in his life were:

- Will: 6 Nov 1587, Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England.¹
- Probate: 14 Dec 1587, Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England.¹ Executors: wife Anne and son John

6. **John Trimmingham** (*William*³, *John*², *William*¹) was buried on 27 Dec 1622.⁵

John married **Brigitta**. Brigitta died in 1605 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England⁷ and was buried on 1 Jan 1605 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England.

General Notes: In her father-in-law William's will he mentions Bridget and her first child (William) who is not yet born: *I bequeath to Briggett Trymyngham my sonnes wyfe and the child nowe in her wombe fourtene pounce betwene them.*

Children from this marriage were:

11 M i. **William Trimmingham** was born ca. 1588 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England, was christened on 31 Jan 1588 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England,⁸ died in 1635 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England⁹ about age 47, and was buried on 28 Oct 1635 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England.

General Notes: According to William E. Trimmingham, a family researcher who unearthed much information on the Trimmingham family of Fishlake, William married Jane Parkin in 1615, probably in Fishlake, and they had three children, John, 1615, Janneta, 1618, and Francis, year of birth unknown. William died in 1635.

14 M iv. **Francis Trimmingham** was born about 1594 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England, was christened on 1 Oct 1594 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England,¹⁶ and died in 1641¹ about age 47.

Francis married **Ellen Ramsden**¹ on 27 Dec 1636 in Sprotbrough, York, England.¹⁷

15 M v. **Edward Trimmingham** was born about 1597 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England, was christened on 29 May 1597 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England,¹⁸ and died in 1606¹ about age 9.

17 M vii. **Richard Trimmingham** was born about 1602 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England and was christened on 18 Apr 1602 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England.²⁰

18 M viii. **George Trimmingham** was born on 13 Oct 1604 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England²¹ and was christened on 21 Oct 1604 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England.²²

John next married **Anne Poole**¹ in 1608 in Nottinghamshire, England.^{23,24}

Marriage Notes: The marriage information, from Paver's Marriage Licenses Index on the Yorkshire page of the Genuki website, for Anne Poole and John Trimmingham notes that they were to be married in Greisley, Yorkshire.

Fifth Generation (Great Great-Grandchildren)

12. John Trimmingham¹⁰ (*John*⁴, *William*³, *John*², *William*¹) was born about 1590 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England,¹¹ was christened on 10 Jan 1590 in Fishlake, West Riding, Yorkshire, England,^{12,13} and died in 1655 in City of London, London, England¹⁴ about age 65.

General Notes: According to researcher Bill Trimmingham of Seattle, John "testified before the High Court of the Admiralty in 1630 that he was forty years of age." This would put his birth at about 1590 and make it a strong possibility that this John was the son of John and Brigitta Trimmingham of Fishlake in Yorkshire. His source for the testimony above: Coldham, P,W., English Adventurers and Emigrants 1609-1660, Genealogical Pub. Co., Baltimore, MD, 1984.

H., comp. *Memorials of the Discovery and Early Settlement of the Bermudas or Somers Islands, 1515-1687* compiled from the colonial records and other original sources by Major-Gen. J.H. LeFroy. London, Longmans, Green, 1877-79. 2 vol.; vol. 1, p.xxxv)

Although he was not governor very long, he was the only governor of Bermuda ever elected. All the others were appointed.

He held office until May 22, 1650. (LeFroy, under errata and addenda)
Governorships did not last long; every two or three years there was a new governor. In 1638 John Trimmingham was Counsellor of Pagets Tribe. (LeFroy, v. 1, p.549)

According to the Bermuda Historical Qtrly., it was a Royalist faction that elected John Trimmingham Governor. Bermuda Historical Quarterly, Vol. 32, #3.

With info. regarding the will of William Green of Paget, Julia Mercer mentions that "Elizabeth and George Brent had a grandson who married Catherine Trimmingham in Bermuda. She was the great granddaughter of the first Trimmingham in the colony". (Mercer, Julia E. *Bermuda Settlers of the 17th Century. Genealogical Notes From Bermuda.* Baltimore, Genealogical Pub. Co., 1982, p.77. (These "notes" were orig. pub. in Tyler's Qtrly. between 1942 and 1947. These are abstracts of the earliest known records of Bermuda settlers.)

Descendants of William Trimmingham

John married **Ann**,²⁷ daughter of **Unknown** and **Unknown**. Ann died about Oct 1677 in Bermuda.²⁸

General Notes: John Trimmingham mentions his wife Ann in his will. According to Julia Mercer's Genealogical Notes, she was most likely a widow when she married John as she had a stepson with the surname Williams. Her maiden name is unknown.

Noted events in her life were:

- Will: Paget, Bermuda, Jan 1673.²⁹
- Will/Probate: Bermuda, 22 Oct 1677.²⁹

Paul married **Jane Nicholls**,^{32,38} daughter of **John Nicholls** and **Unknown**. Jane died before 3 Jun 1689 in Bermuda.³⁹

General Notes: In the will of her husband, who died after her, Jane is mentioned as Paul's late wife, Jane, daughter of John Nicholls.

- 20 F ii. **Bridget Trimmingham**^{40,41,42} was born in England⁴³ and died after 1705 in Bermuda.⁴⁴

Bridget married **Jonothan Turner**,⁴⁵ son of **Jonothan Turner** and **Unknown**, on 24 Aug 1651 in Bermuda.^{46,47} Jonothan died about 1705 in Bermuda.^{48,49}

Noted events in his life were:

- Residence: Devonshire Parish, Bermuda.⁵⁰
- Will: Bermuda, 19 Dec 1705.⁵¹
- Will/Probate: Bermuda, 19 Jul 1710.⁵²

- 21 F iii. **Ann Trimmingham**⁵³ was born in England.⁴³

General Notes: In Bermuda Settlers of the 17th Century, by Julia E. Mercer, p.229, Records from Barbados show a marriage on 27 June 1670 of Mrs. Ann Vaughn and William Daldron. Since John Vaughn did not die until 1678, this is probably not Ann Trimmingham Vaughn (or Vaughan).

Ann married **John Vaughan**⁵⁴ about 27 Sep 1650.⁵⁵ John died about 1678.⁵⁶

Noted events in his life were:

- Will: Bermuda, 29 Oct 1678.⁵⁷
- Will/Probate: Bermuda, 5 Jan 1679.⁵⁶
